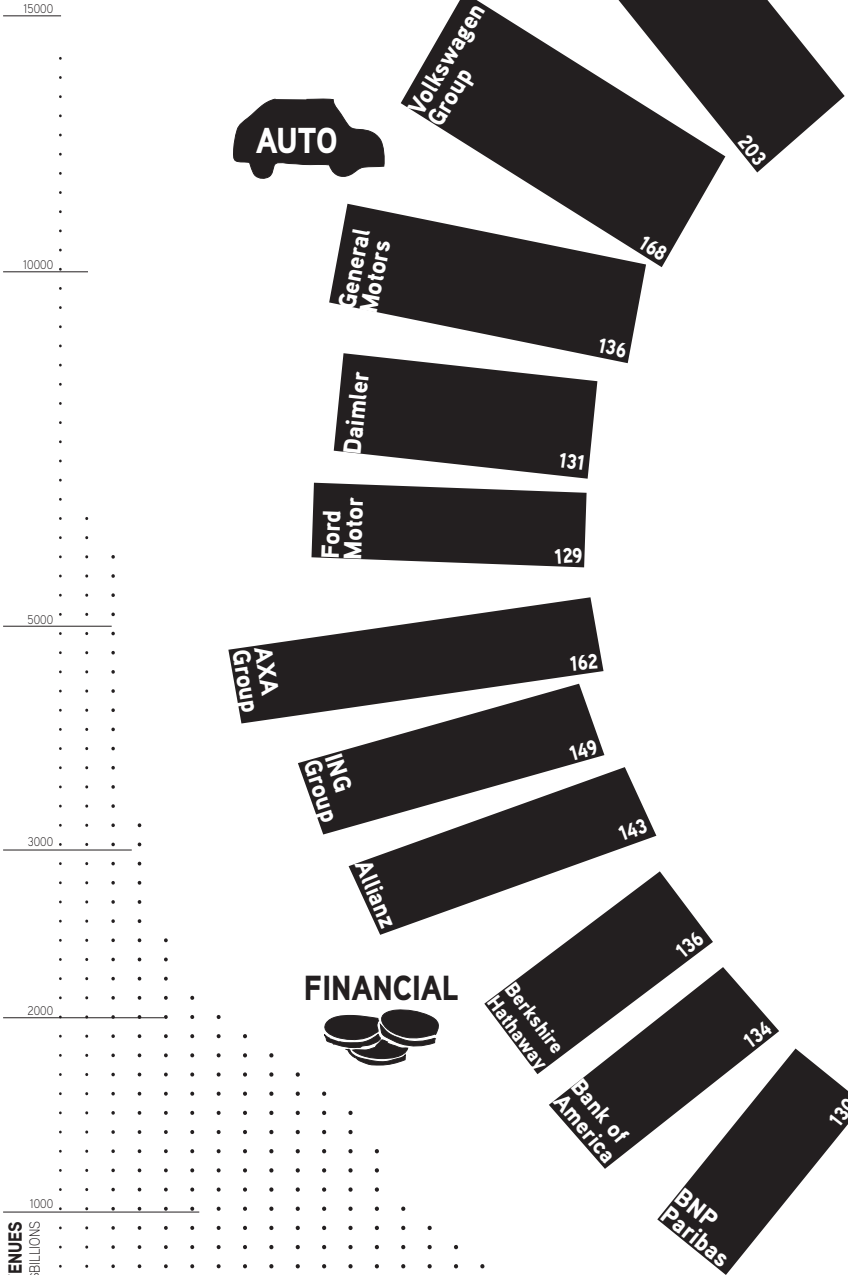
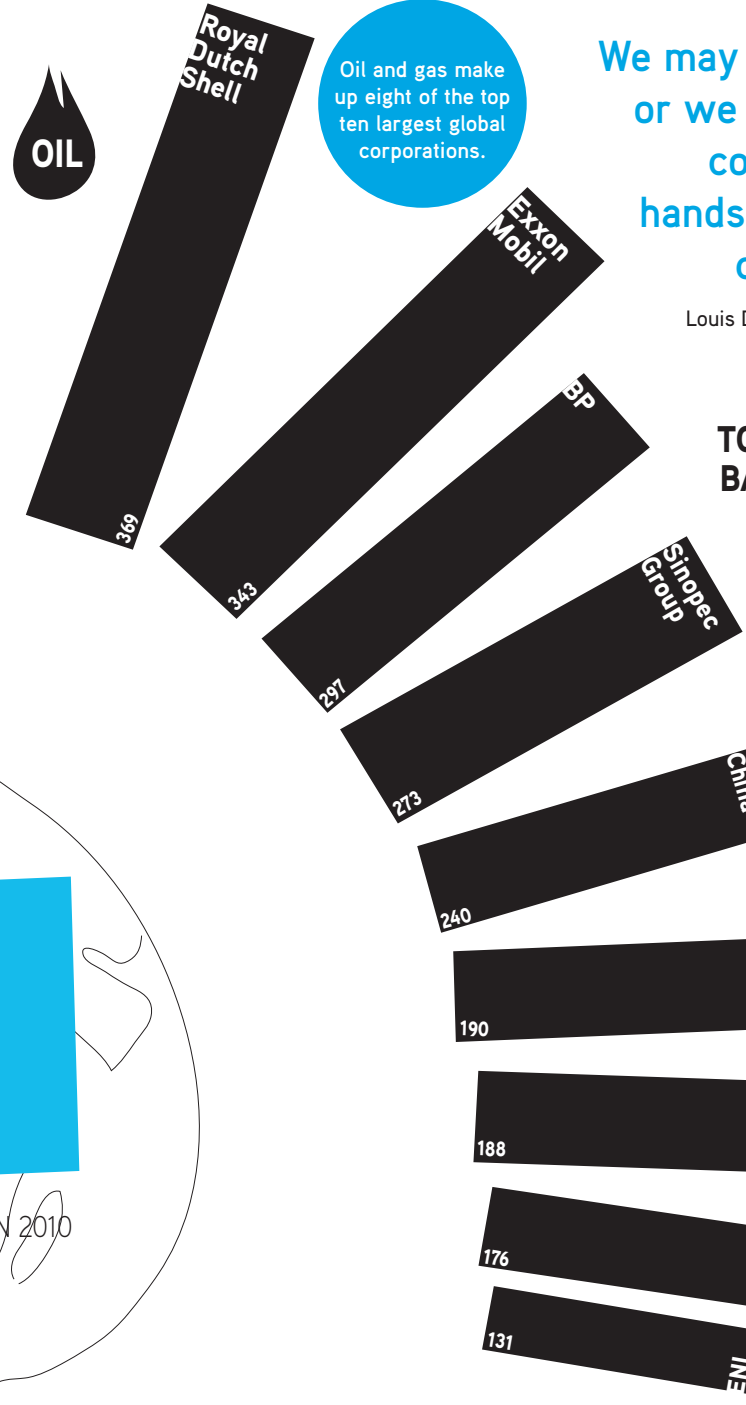
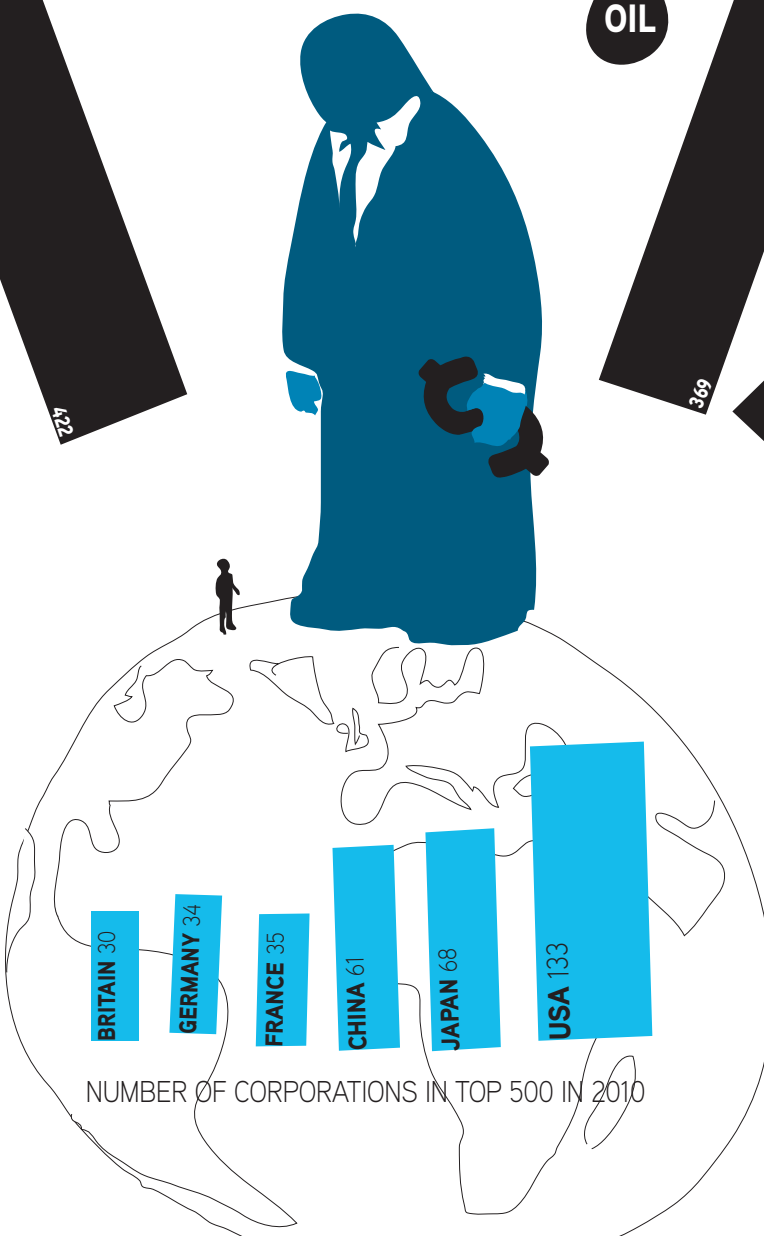

WORLD CONTROLLED BY BIG FINANCE

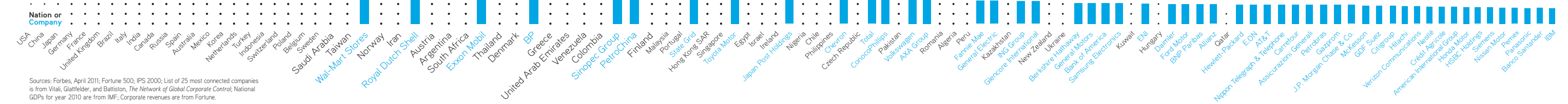
Less than **1%** mostly banks, control the shares of **40%** of global businesses.
